What is a fund?

A fund is a record of any money raised in your child's name.

How do I set one up?

It's quick, and it's easy. Your local community fundraiser can help you create your fund - email **teamCHAS@chas.org.uk** and we'll connect you.

How do I raise funds?

You can raise funds however you want. There's no pressure to raise a certain amount or continue for any length of time.
